Overview

Variety Queensland Motor Mouth Camp 2026

We're excited to invite you to apply for the Variety Motor Mouth Camp 2026!

The Variety Motor Mouth Camp is a three-day, two-night camp designed for children aged 6 to 17 who use Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC), along with their parents/carers and siblings.

This unique camp provides families with the opportunity to learn how to incorporate communication into everyday fun activities in a relaxed, supportive environment. With the guidance of trained professionals, families build confidence using AAC systems while participating in engaging recreational experiences together.

The primary aim of the camp is to support children using AAC to improve their system use and become more competent communicators — all while having fun and strengthening family connections.

What to Expect

- A family-centred camp experience where parents, carers and siblings attend together
- Each family will have dedicated 1:1 support from a trained Speech Pathologist who will provide support tailored to the child's goals and needs
- Structured recreational activities designed to create meaningful communication opportunities
- Professional mentoring from AAC-trained clinicians
- A fun, supportive and inclusive environment
- Opportunities for professional development for students and support volunteers

Key Information

- Organised by Variety Queensland and overseen by Variety Queensland staff, volunteer Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, students, and allied health professionals
- Applications are now open for families and volunteers
- All volunteers must hold a current Working with Children Blue Card

Please note: This is not a respite camp. Families will be asked to actively participate in all activities.

A strict 1:1 adult-to-AAC participant ratio is required. Each AAC participant must have their own dedicated adult in attendance. Siblings can be supervised by another accompanying adult. For example, one AAC participant and one sibling require two adults, while one AAC participant and two siblings can attend with two adults, provided one adult is dedicated to the AAC participant and the other supervises the siblings as required.

Childs Medical Information

A trained First Aid Officer will be appointed and available onsite 24/7 throughout the camp. Their name and contact details will be shared with families on arrival so you know exactly who to reach if needed.

First aid support is available for minor injuries or health concerns. Parents and caregivers are responsible for administering and managing their child's medication and day-to-day medical needs during the camp.

If a more serious medical situation arises, emergency services will be contacted in line with the venue's emergency procedures. These procedures will be explained to all families at the start of camp.

MMC is a wonderful camp designed with the whole family in mind. We encourage families to bring the participant's siblings (under 14), as dedicated sibling activities will be offered around the venue while participants attend their own sessions.

Please note that a strict 1:1 adult-to-AAC participant ratio is required. Each AAC participant must have their own dedicated adult in attendance. Siblings can be supervised by another accompanying adult. For example, one AAC participant and one sibling require two adults, while one AAC participant and two siblings can attend with two adults, provided one adult is dedicated to the AAC participant and the other supervises the siblings as required.

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At least one parent or primary carer must attend camp with the participant. Applications where a participant is accompanied only by a support worker will not be accepted. MMC is designed for participants and their families, including siblings, and having a parent or primary carer present helps ensure each participant receives the support they need throughout the camp experience while allowing families to share in the opportunity together.

Support Workers If required, families may also bring a support worker, provided they are included within the maximum of three adults attending. When signing the declaration, it is the family's responsibility to ensure the support worker has read, understood and agreed to the waiver.

Travel Expenses

Families will need to arrange their own travel to and from camp. As part of our commitment to reaching children right across Queensland, we are offering travel reimbursements of up to \$1,000 for families where travel costs would otherwise prevent attendance.

Please note that funding for travel support is limited and is not available for all families.

Travel expenses must be paid upfront by families. After camp, you can submit a reimbursement claim with supporting receipts.

We kindly ask that you only apply for travel assistance if cost is a genuine barrier to attending camp.

Eligibility

To apply for a travel reimbursement for camp, your family must meet all of the following:

- Live more than **200 km** from the Sunshine Coast Recreation Precinct

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- Be able to pay travel costs upfront and submit a reimbursement claim within **1 month** of camp
- Household income (after tax) must not exceeding \$5,500 per month.

As part of our commitment to expanding our reach to children across Queensland, we are offering travel reimbursements of up to \$1,000 per family to assist with the cost of travelling to and from camp. Families are required to pay for their travel upfront, and a reimbursement claim with supporting receipts can be submitted after camp. Approved reimbursements will be paid directly to the family. Please note that funding is limited and will not cover all families' travel costs.

We kindly ask that you only apply for travel support if the cost of travel would genuinely prevent your family from being able to attend camp.

Important Information

- All travel must be paid upfront and then claimed back. Variety is not able to cover upfront travel costs.
- All claims must be submitted within 1 month after the camp. Claims submitted after this timeframe will not be paid.
- The maximum reimbursement amount is \$1,000 per family.

General Eligibility

To apply for a travel reimbursement, your child must meet all of the following criteria.

- Meet the camp eligibility criteria.
- Live more than 200 km from the Sunshine Coast Recreation Precinct.
- Be able to pay travel costs upfront and submit a reimbursement claim within **1 month** of camp.
- Household income (after tax) must not exceed \$5,500 per month.

Eligible Travel Expenses

The following travel costs can be claimed:

- Uber or taxi fares to and from the airport.
- Mileage from your home address to the camp location, reimbursed at the Queensland ATO rate of \$0.88 per kilometre.
- Hotel accommodation if the total travel time exceeds 10 hours one way.
- Plane tickets.

These Terms apply to all people who attend, volunteer at, or support a Variety Queensland camp. By completing this application, you agree to the following:

Definitions

Variety means Variety – The Children’s Charity of Queensland **Participant** means a child, young person, or adult attending the camp **Guardian** means a parent, carer, or authorised support worker **Staff** means Variety employees, contractors, and volunteers **Camp** means the scheduled activity days and all related transport, accommodation, and excursions

1. Eligibility and Registration

Variety will publish eligibility rules for each camp. You must provide accurate, complete, and up-to-date information and supporting documents as requested.

Places are limited. Variety may accept, decline, or waitlist registrations at its discretion.

You must promptly notify Variety of any changes to health status, medications, accessibility needs, supervision requirements, or emergency contacts by emailing kidssupport@varietyqld.org.au.

1. Safeguarding and Child Safety

Variety is a child-safe organisation and is committed to the safety, wellbeing, and participation of children and young people.

All Staff and volunteers are required to hold and maintain a valid **Blue Card** (or exemption) and comply with Variety’s Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy and Code of Conduct.

Guardians must ensure children attend with appropriate supervision.

Any concerns, disclosures, allegations, or suspicions of harm, abuse, neglect, or exploitation must be reported immediately to Variety Staff. Variety may report matters to Child Safety Services, the Queensland Police Service, or other authorities where required by law.

Variety may remove any person whose behaviour is unsafe, harmful, or inconsistent with child safety requirements.

1. Health, Medical, and Accessibility

To attend camp, you must provide accurate and up-to-date information about any medical conditions, medications, allergies, dietary needs, accessibility requirements, personal care needs, behavioural support needs, or other health and wellbeing considerations for yourself and all members of your family group attending camp.

You acknowledge that medical management remains the responsibility of the participant’s parent/guardian or primary caregiver. This includes the medical care and support of the participant, siblings, support workers, and any other adults or children attending as part of your family group.

Required medications, medical equipment, mobility aids, dietary items, personal care items, or other health-related supports must be supplied, stored and managed by the family. Parents/guardians and primary caregivers remain responsible for administering medications and monitoring ongoing medical needs. Variety does not take responsibility for the storage, administration or monitoring of medications or ongoing medical care, unless otherwise agreed in writing before camp.

In the event of illness, injury or emergency, you authorise Variety to:

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- provide first aid by appropriately trained personnel;
- seek medical treatment;
- contact emergency services; and
- share relevant personal or medical information with medical responders, where required.

You are responsible for any medical, ambulance, treatment or related costs incurred by yourself or any member of your family group.

You accept responsibility for ensuring all members of your family group are appropriately supported, supervised and cared for throughout camp.

Variety may refuse participation or require early departure if a participant's, family member's or support worker's condition, support needs or behaviour presents a safety risk to themselves or others.

1.Risk Acknowledgement and Assumption

Camps involve group, recreational, and outdoor activities. You acknowledge that participation carries inherent risks, including slips, trips, falls, weather exposure, minor injuries, fatigue, and other normal physical or recreational hazards

You agree to:

- Follow all reasonable instructions from the Staff
- Use safety equipment provided
- Participate only in activities appropriate to the Participant's abilities and disclosed needs

1.Supervision and Support

Variety may request additional support, adjust participation, or refuse attendance if care needs exceed available resources.

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1. Transport, Accommodation, and Meals

All transport to and from the camp, activities, accommodation, and meeting points is the responsibility of the Participant and/or Guardian.

1. Privacy and Data Protection

Variety collects personal and sensitive information to manage registration, safety, accessibility, medical needs, and program reporting.

Information will only be shared on a need-to-know basis for safety, care, or legal compliance.

1. Cultural Safety and Inclusion

Participants are encouraged to advise Staff of any cultural, religious, or community needs.

The camp is provided free of charge to families, but it represents a cost to Variety. Last-minute cancellations mean Variety may still incur expenses and cannot offer the place to another family. If you withdraw within two weeks of the camp, for reasons other than unavoidable circumstances, you may be asked to cover costs already incurred by Variety.

These Terms are governed by the laws of Queensland and the Commonwealth of Australia. Queensland courts have non-exclusive jurisdiction.
